

KAFKA - Guided example

	a	b	c

From c3 you see 4 rooms: all the doors in column c and row 3 have to be open.
The same for the space a3: the doors in the column a have to be open as well.
Since from b3 I see a3 and c3, I close the door between b3 and b2; since from c1 I see c2 and c3 and from c2 I see c1 and c3, I close the doors between c1 and b1 and between c2 and b2.
Since from a1 I see a2 and a3, I close the door between a1 and b1.
The doors between b1 and b2 and between a2 and b2 stay open: the map is not complete.
